The Openness of Local Government Bodies Regulations 2014

Recording of decisions

7.—(1) The decision-making officer must produce a written record of any decision which falls

within paragraph (2).

(2) A decision falls within this paragraph if it would otherwise have been taken by the relevant

local government body, or a committee, sub-committee of that body or a joint committee in which

that body participates, but it has been delegated to an officer of that body either-

(a) under a specific express authorisation; or

(b) under a general authorisation to officers to take such decisions and, the effect of the decision is to—

(i) grant a permission or licence;

(ii) affect the rights of an individual; or

(iii) award a contract or incur expenditure which, in either case, materially affects that relevant local government body's financial
